

The Rutgers S.A.F.E.T.Y Clinic (Sports Awareness for Educating Today's Youth) is a three hour program that meets the "Minimum Standards for Volunteer Coaches Safety Orientation and Training Skills Programs" (N.J.A.C. 5:52) and provides partial civil immunity protection to volunteer coaches under the "Little League Law" (2A:62A-6 et.seq.). The course is not specific to any particular sport. It provides the same legal protections to the coaching of any sport.

The course only needs to be attended once. If you've taken the clinic in a prior year you need not take it again.

The course will be offered in Franklin Township, Somerset County, at the Senior/Community Center located in the Franklin Township Municipal Complex at 475 DeMott Lane, Somerset N.J. (The Senior/Community Center is located at the rear of the complex, past the Police Department.) The clinic will be held on **Tuesday, September 28th**. Registration will be from 6:00 p.m. to 6:30 p.m. The course will start promptly at 6:30 p.m. and go until 9:30 p.m. For attendees who are not coaching for the Franklin Township Soccer Club, the fee for the clinic is \$30.

THE DOORS WILL BE LOCKED AT 6:30 P.M. LATECOMERS WILL BE TURNED AWAY.

You must register in advance if you wish to attend. To register, please send an email message to jkuligowski@comcast.net with your name, the name of your organization and a contact email or evening phone number so that your registration can be confirmed and you can be reached should any changes need to be made.

Generally the course fills up. Note that you are not registered until you get a reply message that you are indeed registered.
