- o F.T.S.C., in concert with the New Jersey Youth Soccer Association aims for "balanced abilities on teams". The Club will roster players on teams it deems necessary to accomplish this primary goal, and makes no guarantee that special requests for specific coaches, players or practice locations will be honored. The Division Manager's decision is final.
- o Both shin guards and soccer cleats are required for team play (note: non-soccer footwear with front toe cleats will not be allowed). If this requirement is a financial hardship, please see any Executive Board member for solution options.
- o Please see the reverse side for Club policies and procedures concerning required practice / game field behavior of all Club members and spectators
- o Child must be age 6 by October 31 to play in the PW1 or PW2 Divisions for the fall season and subsequent spring season. The Nippers Program is available to players not meeting this requirement.

I agree to abide by all Club policies and procedures and am aware that failure to comply will result in disciplinary action, up to and including expulsion from the Club.

I have been advised that youth soccer players should have a medical exam before participating in soccer; that the F.T.S.C. should be informed of all ailments and/or physical limitations that could affect participation. A "release-to-play" note may be required from my physician. I, the parent / guardian, recognize that any activity involving motion or contact can create a possibility of injury. I hereby release the F.T.S.C. and its volunteers from claims of any injuries that may be sustained while participating in the program.

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SPECTATORS AND COACHES RULES OF CONDUCT

The philosophy of the Franklin Township Soccer Club is that children's sports are about participation, sportsmanship, character development, and other healthy habits that last a lifetime. Children play organized sports for their own fun. They are not there to entertain adults, and they are not miniature pro athletes. We'll all enjoy the game more if we just let them play.

- 1.) Be on your best behavior and set a proper example.
- 2.) Coaches need to be in charge of and are responsible for the conduct of their players on the field and their spectators on the sidelines.
- 3.) It is the coach's responsibility to discuss any issues with the referee or opposing coach, never the parents, spectators or players.
- 4.) Spectators should not be coaching from the sidelines. Coaching is not your job: it confuses the players, and makes them tense.
- 5.) Know the difference between positive cheering and negative berating.
- 6.) Spectators are to stay behind the orange line on the sidelines. Spectators and coaches are also not allowed behind the goal area.
- 7.) Referees, especially young ones, are doing a difficult job. We recognize errors in judgment may occur, however, they still deserve total support. Respect their decision.
- 8.) Never ridicule or scold a child for making a mistake during a game.
- 9.) Show respect for your team's opponents. Without them, there would be no games.
- 10.) Coaches should make a concerted effort not to allow their team to run up a score. Winning a game by five goals or more is demoralizing to the opposing team. Parents and spectators should support the club's philosophy in striving for balanced and competitive games.
- 11.) Family and friends are welcome as spectators but family pets are not. They can't appreciate the game. Please be kind to them and leave your pets at home.

Set a good example for yourself, by showing good sportsmanship, and cheering positively.

IT WILL CATCH ON!

The following infractions will result in immediate removal from the fields and potential expulsion from the club:

- 1.) Fighting or improper physical contact, or the threat thereof.
- 2.) Harassment or continued verbal abuse.
- 3.) Continuance of improper behavior after being warned.
- 4.) Failure to comply with a FTSC official's request to obey the league's rules.
- 5.) Failure to comply with a FTSC official's request to leave the fields.
- 6.) Conduct which results in the violation of a law or court order.

The following infractions will result in a warning and then removal from the fields if the behavior continues:

- 1.) Use of profanity
- 2.) Verbal abuse of players, coaches, youth referees, or league administrators.
- 3.) Loud, excessive, or negative shouting from spectators.
- 4.) Arguing (dissenting) with the referee.
- 5.) Any other conduct which, in the League's discretion, is in contravention to these Rules of Conduct.

1. ___ **Head Coach** - indicate for which child(ren) _____

3. ___ **Team Parent** – helps coach: calls, schedules and organizes (oranges, pictures, trophies, ice)
4. ___ **Concession Stand Help** – work in concession stand for three hours
5. ___ **Information Desk Help** – work at information desk for three hours
6. ___ **Pre-games set-up** - place cones in parking lot, sets up tables, etc. (8-9 AM; 3 times per season)
7. ___ **Post-games shut-down** - put cones/tables away, discard trash... (2-3 PM; 3 times per season)
8. ___ **Field Liner** – responsible for lining one field per week throughout the season
9. ___ **Field Preparation Day Assistance** (pre-season) – help line fields prior to opening day
10. ___ **Uniform Manager** or Assistant (primarily pre-season) – help confirm uniform orders
11. ___ **Festivity Day Assistant** – help cook hotdogs, hand out food to teams on last day season
12. ___ **Equipment Manager's Assistant** - help hang new nets, prepare bags (balls, cones, first aid kits)
13. ___ **Trophy Manager** or Assistant – select trophies, check order forms, transport trophies to field
14. ___ **Field Maintenance** – field repair (fill holes, rake, reseed as necessary) and maintenance
15. ___ **Division Manager** – create balanced team rosters, select coaches (yearly – all fees waived)
16. ___ **Nippers Program Manager** – Oversee Nippers Program (yearly – all fees waived)
17. ___ **Nippers Assistant Manager** – Assist in organizing schedules, registrations and as necessary
18. ___ **Nippers Assistant Coach** – Teach/Coach Nippers under direction of Nippers Head Instructor
19. ___ **Nippers Administrator** – inform families of Nippers when to arrive on the first day and any changes throughout season via e-mail and phone.
20. ___ **Executive Board Member** (multi-year by vote – registration and uniforms fees waived fully)
21. ___ **Activities as requested by Executive Board**
22. ___ I am unable to volunteer any time before, during or after the season
